

Designing an integrated digital healthcare framework for low income chronic disease patients in South Africa

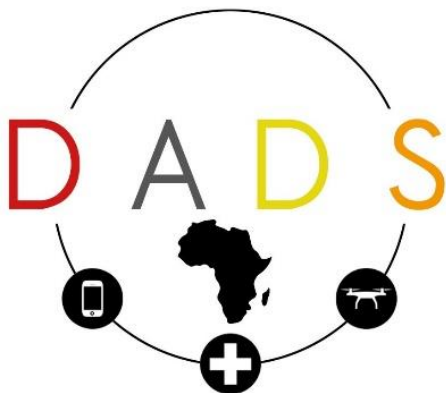
Purpose
